PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES CAN CALL DISABILITY RIGHTS CONNECTICUT TO FIND OUT:

- If you are a registered voter.
- To register to vote.
- How to become a registered voter.
- How to obtain an absentee ballot (vote by mail).
- About accessible voting options.
- How to obtain accommodations in order to vote (i.e., having a ballot emailed to you, having the ballot in another language, etc.).
- More information about voting rights.

Your Rights Are:

- You may see a ballot in advance.
- You may vote by mail.
- You may get a new ballot if you make a mistake.
- You may leave some choices blank on the ballot.
- You may receive disability-related accommodations.
